The Care Quality Commission (CQC) regulates homecare providers in England to ensure they meet strict safety, quality, and care standards.

What to Look For:

The provider should be CQC-registered—you can verify this on the [CQC website](#).

Check their CQC rating:

- ♥ **Outstanding** – Exceeds care standards.
- ♥ **Good** – Meets all requirements.
- ♥ **Requires Improvement** – Some concerns noted.
- ♥ **Inadequate** – Fails to meet essential standards (AVOID).

Step 2

Ask About Carer Qualifications & Training

- ♥ They should receive mandatory training in:
 - » Moving & Handling
 - » Medication Management
 - » Infection Control
 - » First Aid & CPR
- ♥ Specialist training for complex needs (e.g., dementia, palliative care, stroke recovery).
